The Senior Environmental Consultant is responsible for independently managing Phase I and II Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs) and subsurface investigations for residential, commercial, and industrial properties.

- Plan, design, and direct Phase I ESA and Phase II investigations in accordance with regulatory requirements.
- Review and interpret analytical data, developing strategies for managing soil, groundwater, surface water, and vapor contamination.
- Prepare technical reports with clear conclusions and actionable recommendations, demonstrating a thorough understanding of regulatory compliance.
- Coordinate and oversee field activities, including drilling of soil borings, installation of groundwater monitoring wells, excavation of contaminated soils/materials, wetland delineations, and geotechnical evaluations.
- Communicate project requirements and schedules, findings, and recommendations to clients, regulatory agencies, and internal staff.
- Perform business development activities including developing and maintaining client relationships, attending networking events, participating in conferences and seminars, and actively pursuing involvement in professional organizations.
- Prepare proposals for various project opportunities and establish reasonable budgets and scopes of work.
- Facilitate the development of sites for redevelopment, including environmental cleanup and pre-demo inspections.
